Safety Tips for use of agricultural Chemicals

- Avoid inhalation
- Avoid eye contact
- Avoid oral contact
- Avoid skin contact
- Identify all products
- Avoid heat and flame
- Mix chemicals carefully
- Keep out of reach of children
- Know the storage requirements
